"World Class - Angove's top-tier spirits are bottled in tiny batches, as you'd expect of brandies with average ages of 20-year-old in Imperial XO (97/100, \$295) and the 40-year-old Grand Reserve (97/100, \$795). These brandies are world class, and about as complex as distillates from the grape can get." "Massive depth here: creme brulee and crystallised bitter orange. A fabulously, complex palate: fruit and nut cake and perfectly-formed phenolics, which gives the "grip" at the finish. Has a delightful, burnished patina about it, as well as concentrated flavour (this is, after all, 20 years in oak). Marvellous stuff, world-class brandy."

"Deep amber in colour, the St Agnes XO Imperial 20 Year Old boasts a nose that is a myriad of creme caramel, toffee apples, and Christmas cake with underlying chocolate, apricots and almonds. The palate is long with ethereal rancio characters of truffle, walnut, chocolate and poached pear."

The palate is refined, elegant and very long, with a clean finish and no rough edges to its spirit, nor oakiness. A superb brandy of great class."
